RENTAL AGREEMENT:

It is mutually agreed that the following terms apply to Pennington Conservation District's rental program.

Effective March 1, 2015. The producer is responsible for setting the drill. Instructions for setting the drill are provided via the operator's manual located with the drill.

The producer will be responsible for all repairs other than normal wear.

THE COST FOR RENTING THE DRILL WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

\$500.00 Damage Deposit (leave check before drill goes out) (if no damage, use towards payment or give back THE Check)

\$200 Minimum charge (under 19 acres)

\$50 Per Day

\$8.00 Per Acre

A drop charge may be assessed for out-of-county, or extreme distances.

The drill will be transported to the site by the producer, and returned by the producer after the work has been completed and the producer has notified the district. Any damages to the drill beyond normal wear and tear will be assessed on the final billing. The drill must be checked out with the damage deposit, which can be applied to the final bill if no damage is assessed upon inspection of the drill once it is returned.

When the producer picks up the drill the acre-counter will be read and noted on the agreement. The acre-counter will be read upon completion of drilling and the drill is returned to the district.

A bill will be prepared after the drill has been used and returned. This bill will reflect the amount due. All sums are immediately due and payable upon receipt of the bill. A finance charge will be applied after 30 days.

It is the producer's responsibility to vacuum out any remaining seed left in the boxes. If the District has to clean the drill, there will be an additional \$50 clean-up charge.

DRILL USAGE

TRANSPORT

****DISENGAGE GEARS WHILE IN TRANSIT, LOCATED IN THE REAR OF THE DRILL**

-WHEN RETURNING THE DRILL MAKE SURE DRILL IS LIFTED AND LOCKED UP AND HYDRAULIC HOSES ARE STORED IN THE PROPER POSITION AND TURNED OFF

IN THE FIELD

-MAKE SURE YOU ARE LOOKING AT THE CORRECT SEED CHART FOR GEAR RATIO TO ENSURE YOU GET THE CORRECT AMOUNT OF SEED *NOTE-THE DRILL HAS A HALF SPEED SPROCKET SO BE SURE YOU FOLLOW SEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

-CHECK THE DEPTH BANDS TO MAKE SURE THE SEED IS WHERE YOU WANT IT

CLEANING

-PLEASE GREASE THE DRILL BEFORE YOU RETURN IT, IN THE CASE OF A QUICK TURN-AROUND TO ANOTHER PRODUCER (THERE ARE 4 SETS OF GREASE ZERKS)

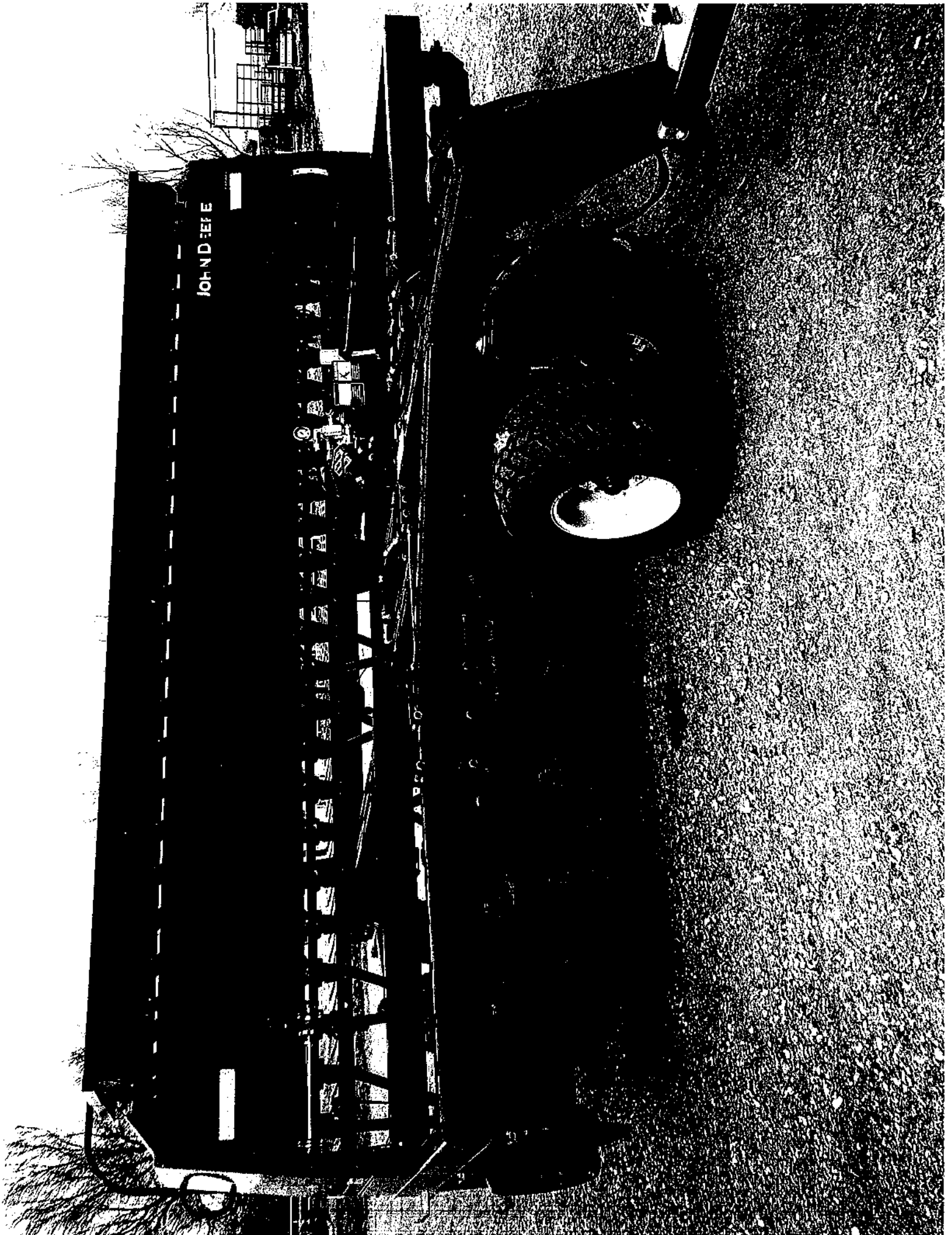
-DROP PLATES ON THE SEED CUPS AND BLOW THEM OUT AND MAKE SURE BINS ARE CLEAN

ACREAGE

-BE SURE TO RESET THE ACRE METER TO ZERO PRIOR TO USE OF THE DRILL AND DOCUMENT THE ACRES DRILLED WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED TO REPORT TO THE CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR BILLING PURPOSES, THEN RESET METER TO ZERO.

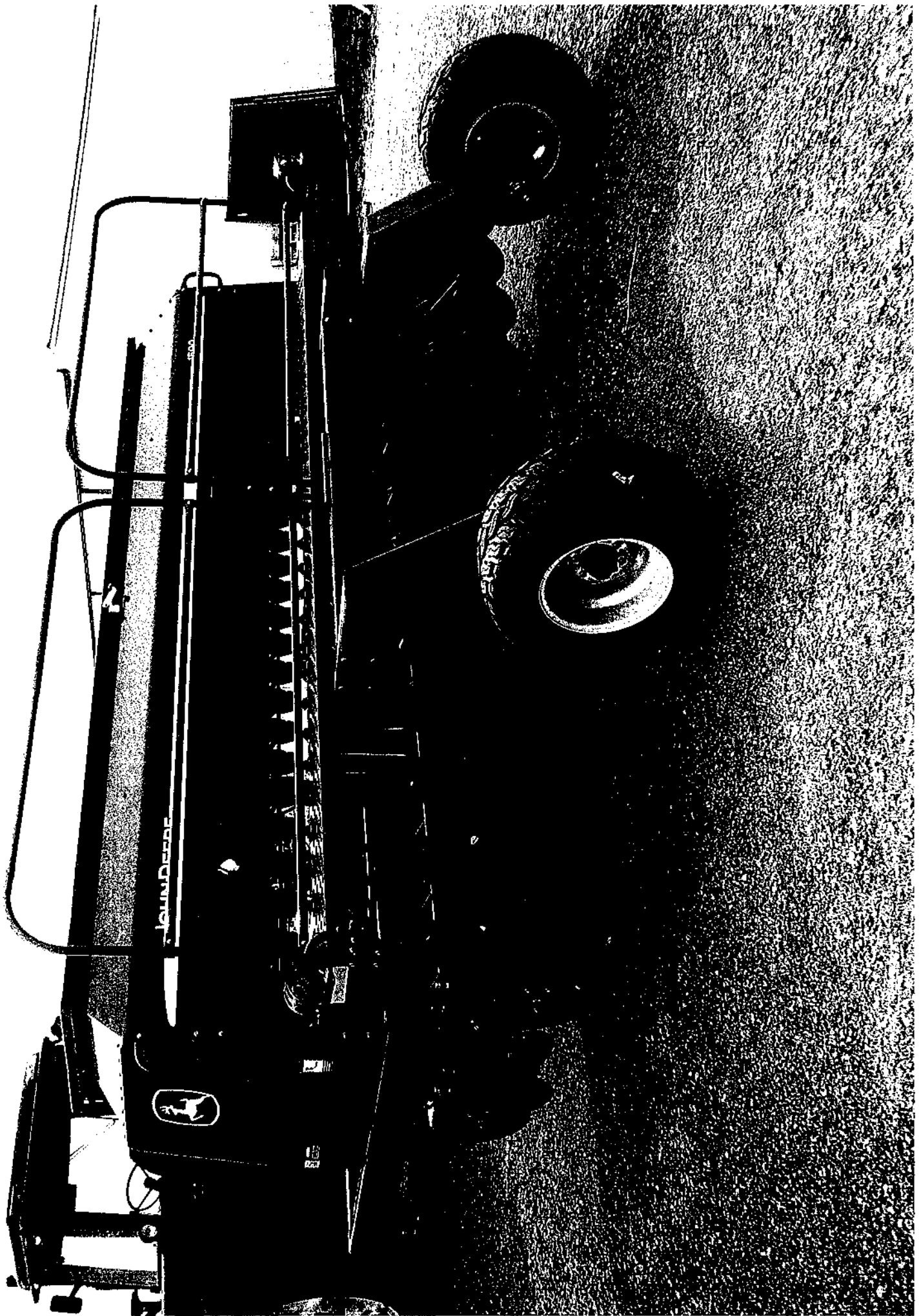
DAMAGE

-PLEASE NOTIFY ME IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE TO THE DRILL SO THAT IT MAY BE FIXED IN A TIMELY MANNER, SO AS TO NOT HINDER THE SCHEDULE OF OTHER PRODUCERS (ie.BENT STEPS, MISSING TUBES, HOSES)
