ALL ORDERS SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY OF NURSERY STOCK. You will be contacted in the spring when your trees are ready for pick up. Numerous conditions over which we have no control often govern results that customers may have with plants. Because of these conditions of which we can exercise no control, it is impossible to guarantee planting results and continued growth of plants. All trees are conservation size seedlings (2-3 yrs. old).

NOW AVAILABLE WEED BARRIER FABRIC MULCH AND INSTALLATION

WHY USE FABRIC MULCH?

- ◆ Enhanced survival and growth on trees and shrubs. The percent of survival is usually above 95% as compared to 50% or less.
- ◆ Eliminates the need for cultivation, drip systems, weed badger work, and chemicals on most plantings.
- ◆ In a Wyoming experiment, soil moisture was measured for two years under fabric and in nearby clean cultivation plots. Results indicate that soil moisture under the fabric did not fall below 80% of field capacity while dropping to nearly 3% under clean cultivation.
- ◆ Tree and shrub plantings and fabric installation can both be done by machine thus the entire operation is fast and efficient.

COST OF FABRIC AND INSTALLATION:

\$0.60 per linear foot (in 6 ft. width) for installations over 900 lin.ft.

For installations less than 900 lin.ft., add a \$50.00 set down fee per installation

Fabric mulch rolls and squares are also available for purchase. Contact the Conservation District for widths and pricing.

COST OF TREE AND SHRUB PLANTING:

\$2.00 per tree/shrub and machine planting. You provide a minimum 50 HP tractor and driver. Ground **must** be properly prepared.

For installations less than 200 trees, add a \$50.00 set down fee per planting.

Help must be provided to heel in the trees after planting.
